

CITY OF TEA ORDINANCE 156

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE SPEED ON THE STREET AND PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAYS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TEA.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEA, SOUTH DAKOTA:

1. That Section 8.03 of the Tea City Ordinances be amend to read as follows:


(a) General Restrictions.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on a street or highway at a speed great than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions then existing or at a speed in excess of those fixed by this Title.

(b) Speed Zones:

(i) Unless otherwise posted, no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of twenty (20) miles per hour within the corporate limits of the City of Tea. The City shall cause signs to be posted informing drivers of the speed limit as set forth in this section.

(ii) No person shall drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour while passing through a school zone, or while traveling upon any street on or across which children are passing going to and from school during school days when such children are present.
