City of Tea Regular Meeting March 3, 2014

A regular meeting of the Tea City Council was held at Tea City Hall on March 2, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor John Lawler called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Sidney Munson, Brian Fowlds, Chuck Ortmeier, Joe Weis and Todd Boots. Also present: Finance Officer Dawn Murphy, Administrative Assistant/Economic Development Director Jenni White, Police Chief Clark Baker, Utility Superintendent Thad Konrad, Planning & Zoning Administrator Kevin Nissen, Park and Recreation Assistant Jamie Newborg and City Engineer Jason Kjenstad. Councilmember Herman Otten was absent.

AGENDA. MOTION 14-35. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the March 3, 2014 agenda. All members voted AYE.

MINUTES. MOTION 14-36. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Boots to approve the February 18, 2014 minutes. All members voted AYE.

WARRANTS. MOTION 14-37. MOTION by Ortmeier, seconded by Fowlds to approve the warrants as presented. All members voted AYE. Warrants will be listed at the end of the minutes.

CONCESSION STAND UPDATE. Jamie updated the council on the plan for running concessions this summer. Vicki Pick has offered to oversee the concession stand this summer. Everett Johnson is planning on assisting her and using it as his senior project. Vicki will be putting together a list of equipment that the city will need to purchase. The youth group at St. Nicholas Catholic Church has inquired about running the concession stand for the fields at the high school.

JIM IHNEN was present to ask for approval to have his outdoor concert on Friday night June 20th in the parking lot south of the Tea Steak House. **MOTION 14-38. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the Tea Steak House/O'Tooles bar to host an outside concert/dance on June 20th, from 9:00 p.m. to 1:00 a.m in the parking lot between the restaurant and legion building. All members voted AYE. There was a brief discussion on additional parking for the motorcycle poker run on June 21st. Jim is not opposed to adding additional parking to the center of Main Ave. as long as the whole street is not blocked off.

APPOINTMENT OF PARK AND RECREATION BOARD MEMBERS. There are three terms that have expired and one resignation on the park and recreation board. **MOTION 14-39. MOTION** by Weis, seconded by Fowlds to appoint the following individuals to the Tea Park and Recreation Board: Kurt Zabel, term expires 2016; Kurt Hoff, term expires 2016; and Jeff Portner, term expires 2014. All members voted AYE. There is still one opening on the board.

POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICY. The council reviewed the policy that Chief Baker handed out at the last meeting regarding vehicle accidents. **MOTION 14-40. MOTION** by Ortmeier, seconded by Fowlds to approve Tea Police Department Policy and Procedure #47, Vehicle Accidents. All members voted AYE.

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ENGINEERING. HDR is working on the sidewalk project; Thad and Lance have been working on the overlay project; they are continuing to work on the 468th Ave. pipe project; the Water/Sewer Master Plan has been completed and the council will review it at the April 7th meeting at 6:00.

COMMITTEE REPORTS. Kevin has been notified that the city will be receiving at least \$204,000 from the trail grant that we applied for. There is also a chance that we could receive an additional \$204,000 if another community declines their grant. This money would be used for a trail to be installed around the new athletic complex. The police department has been trained on CPR and how to use the AED machine. Brock Nelson and Matt Wetterling have attended a fire arms school. The new design for the Tea website has been completed.
