City of Tea Regular Meeting July 6, 2015

A regular meeting of the Tea City Council was held at Tea City Hall on July 6, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor John Lawler called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. with the following members present: Sidney Munson, Brian Fowlds, Chuck Ortmeier, Joe Weis, Larry Rieck and Todd Boots. Also present: Finance Officer Dawn Murphy, Utility Superintendent Thad Konrad, Planning & Zoning Administrator Kevin Nissen, Police Chief Jessica Quigley and Administrative Assistant/Economic Development Director Jenni White. City Engineer Jason Kjenstad was absent.

**AGENDA. MOTION 15-127. MOTION** by Ortmeier, seconded by Weis to approve the July 6, 2015 agenda. All members voted AYE.

**MINUTES. MOTION 15-128. MOTION** by Weis, seconded by Fowlds to approve the June 15, 2015 minutes. All members voted AYE.

**WARRANTS. MOTION 15-129. MOTION** by Weis, seconded by Rieck to approve the July warrants as presented. All members voted AYE. Warrants will be listed at the end of the minutes.

**SITE PLAN**. Kevin presented a site plan for Carl Soukup, Tea Building Corporation for a 12,000 sq. ft. building in the Carl Soukup Addition. The building will be used for potential industrial type businesses. HDR Engineering has reviewed the site plan and recommends approval. **MOTION 15-130. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Weis to approve the building site plan for Carl Soukup, Tea Building Corporation, Lot 3, Block 2, Carl W. Soukup's Addition. All members voted AYE.

**BUILDING PERMIT**. Kevin has received a building permit application from Morton Buildings to construct a building on Lot 3, Block 2, Carl W. Soukup's Addition for Matthew Millage and Carl Soukup. For now it will just be a building shell for potential tenants. **MOTION 15-131. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Weis to approve the building permit for Morton Buildings, 201 Lipton St. All members voted AYE.

**ATHLETIC COMPLEX PHASE 3.** There was discussion on digging a well to help with watering the additional flex space that is being constructed. Additional costs and what the water quality would be needs to be further researched before a decision is made.

**SIDEWALK ASSESSMENT**. There was discussion on implementing a sidewalk maintenance fee similar to the street maintenance fee. This would be used to repair resident's sidewalks when needed. This would make the process much easier for the city and homeowner. An example of the assessment would be a \$.10 per foot assessment on an average 80 foot lot, the property owner would pay \$8.00 per year. This would generate approximately \$19,000 per year. No decision was made.

**POLICE OFFICER RESIGNATION. MOTION 15-132. MOTION** by Weis, seconded by Fowlds to accept Police Officer Brock Nelson's resignation effective June 27, 2015. All members voted AYE.

**POLICE OFFICER HIRING. MOTION 15-133. MOTION** by Fowlds, seconded by Rieck to hire Vance Siemonsma as a full time police officer at 17.00 per hour effective July 5, 2015. All members voted AYE.

**COMMITTEE REPORTS**. The budget meeting will be August 17, 2015 starting at 6:00. Chief Quigley handed out a sample ordinance that permits golf carts on city streets. Embrace Church will be closing part of Figzel Court for a family day on July 26. Councilmember Fowlds has been contact by a company called

DigiFarm wondering if the City would allow them to put a base station in City Hall for their system. They would be able to plug their equipment into the existing but not operational system that is already here. All they would need is power and internet access. In turn they would give us a lifetime subscription to their product. Brian will get additional information for the next meeting.
