City of Tea Regular Meeting July 18, 2016

A regular meeting of the Tea City Council was held at Tea City Hall on July 18, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor John Lawler called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. with the following members present: Sidney Munson, Brian Fowlds, Chuck Ortmeier, Joe Weis, Larry Rieck and Todd Boots. Also present: Finance Officer Dawn Murphy, Planning & Zoning Administrator Kevin Nissen, Police Chief Jessica Quigley and City Engineer Ben Scholtz. Administrative Assistant/Economic Development Director Jenni White and Utility Superintendent Thad Konrad were absent.

AGENDA. MOTION 16-130. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the July 18, 2016 agenda. All members voted AYE.

MINUTES. MOTION 16-131. MOTION by Ortmeier, seconded by Rieck to approve the June 20, 2016 minutes. All members voted AYE.

WARRANTS. MOTION 16-132-. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Fowlds to approve the warrants as presented. All members voted AYE. Warrants will be listed at the end of the minutes.

WEISER DISTRIBUTING BUILDING. Bob Weiser was present to discuss the plans for the addition they would like to add on to the south side of their building. In order to meet the 5 foot setback required for the size of building they are proposing, they would need to purchase approximately 30 feet of land from the City. There is also a waterline that would need to be relocated. The council will try to look at the site before a decision will be made.

JOSMER SITE PLAN. Kevin presented and recommended approval of a site plan for a 13,431 sq. ft. building for contractor shops in the Carl Soukup Addition. **MOTION 16-133. MOTION** by Rieck, seconded by Fowlds to approve the site plan for Josmer Enterprises to construct a 13,431 sq. ft. building on Lot 4, Block 2, Carl W. Soukup Addition. All members voted AYE.

BUILDING PERMIT. Kevin presented and recommended approval of the building plan and building permit for Josmer Enterprises. **MOTION 16-134. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Fowlds to approve the building plans and building permit #16-102 for Josmer Enterprises. All members voted AYE.

JAVERS SITE PLAN. Kevin presented and recommended approval of a site plan for a 15,720 sq. ft. building for contractor shops in the Southwest Industrial Park Addition. **MOTION 16-135. MOTION** by Weis, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the site plan for Chad Javers to construct a 15,720 sq. ft. building on Tract 23, Southwest Industrial Park Addition. All members voted AYE.

PLAT. Kevin presented and recommended approval of a plat in Artisan Addition. **MOTION 16-136**. **RESOLUTION 16-07-12**. **MOTION** by Rieck, seconded by Boots to approve the following resolution. All members voted AYE. **BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Tea, South Dakota that the plat knows and described as Lots 5-10 Block 2; Lots 1-11, Block 3; Lots 2-9, Block 4; and Lots 8-12 Block 5, Artisan Addition, lying within jurisdictional limits of the City of Tea, South Dakota, is hereby approved and the City Finance Officer of the City of Tea, South Dakota is hereby directed to endorse on such plat a copy of this resolution and certify the same thereon. Dated this July 18, 2016.

ENGINEERING. A design contract for 271st Street and a contract for the archaeological survey will be approved at the next meeting. Preconstruction meeting for the sidewalk project will be July 21. There was a meeting with SD Game Fish and Parks on the 468th Ave. drainage issue. They will continue to research different options.

EMPLOYEE PAY INCREASE. MOTION 16-137. MOTION by Fowlds, seconded by Rieck to approve a pay increase for Park and Recreation Assistant Jenna Biedenfeld from 16.00 to 16.50 retroactive to July 11, 2016. All members voted AYE.

COMMITTEE REPORTS. The 2017 budget meeting will be August 29 at 6:00. It was the consensus of the council to declare an old scoreboard surplus property and donate it to the City of Hurley. This will be done at the next meeting. There was some damage to the bleachers, fence and storage building at Field 9 and 10, by the high school. Insurance reports have been filed.
