City of Tea Regular Meeting September 19, 2016

A regular meeting of the Tea City Council was held at Tea City Hall on September 19, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor John Lawler called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Brian Fowlds, Chuck Ortmeier, Joe Weis, Larry Rieck and Todd Boots. Also present: Finance Officer Dawn Murphy, Utility Superintendent Thad Konrad, Planning & Zoning Administrator Kevin Nissen and Police Chief Jessica Quigley. Administrative Assistant/Economic Development Director Jenni White and Councilmember Sidney Munson were absent.

AGENDA. MOTION 16-168. MOTION by Rieck, seconded by Weis to approve the September 19, 2016 agenda with the addition of executive session for contracts. All members voted AYE.

MINUTES. MOTION 16-169. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Fowlds to approve the August 29 and September 6, 2016 minutes. All members voted AYE.

WARRANTS. MOTION 16-170-. MOTION by Fowlds, seconded by Boots to approve the warrants as presented. All members voted AYE. Warrants will be listed at the end of the minutes.

VARIANCE PUBLIC HEARING. As this was the time set, Mayor Lawler opened the public hearing for a setback variance for Earl and Thomas Jacobson to construct an addition to their property. The 40' x 12' garage would encroach approximately two-feet into the side yard setback. If granted a 1 hour firewall would be required on the outside wall. The zoning board does not recommend granting the variance. **MOTION 16-171. MOTION** by Ortmeier, seconded by Weis to approve the side yard setback variance, allowing the setback to be 3 feet from the property line for Earl Jacobson, 130 E. 3rd St., Lot 8, Block 2, Fritz Addition, with the condition that a one hour firewall is constructed on the outside wall. Members Ortmeier, Boots, Rieck and Weis voted AYE. Member Fowlds voted NO. Motion carried.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 236. The council held the second reading of Ordinance 236 rezoning portions of Boulder Addition. **MOTION 16-172. MOTION** by Fowlds, seconded by Rieck to approve Ordinance 236, An Ordinance of the City of Tea, Rezoning Tract 3 Boulder Addition from Agriculture to General Business Commercial (GB), Residential (R1 & R2) and Natural Resource Conservation (NRC). All members voted AYE. The ordinance will be published separately.

KAUL'S ADDITION PLAT. Kevin presented and recommended approval of a plat in Kaul's Addition. **MOTION 16-173. RESOLUTION 16-09-14. MOTION** by Rieck, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the following resolution. Members Ortmeier, Boots, Rieck and Weis voted AYE. Member Fowlds abstained. Motion carried. **BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Tea, South Dakota that the plat knows and described as Tract 1, Kaul's Addition, lying within the platting jurisdiction limits of the City of Tea, South Dakota, is hereby approved and the City Finance Officer of the City of Tea, South Dakota is hereby directed to endorse on such plat a copy of this resolution and certify the same thereon. Dated this 19th day of September, 2016.

MARKEN PROPERTIES SITE PLAN. Kevin presented and recommended approval of a site plan for a 7,500 sq. ft. building for a landscape supply shop. **MOTION 16-174. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Weis to approve the site plan for Marken Properties to construct a 7,500 sq. ft. building at 300 High Pointe St., Lot 3, Block 3 Carl Soukup Addition. Members Ortmeier, Boots, Rieck and Weis voted AYE. Member Fowlds abstained. Motion carried.

TEA TOWN HOMES SITE PLAN. Kevin presented and recommend approval of a site plan for Tea Townhomes. **MOTION 16-175. MOTION** by Fowlds, seconded by Rieck to approve the site plan for Lloyd Companies to construct 61 townhome units and garages on Lots 4A, 5A, 7, 8 and 9, Block 1, Zelmer 2nd Addition. All members voted AYE.

EVERTT'S PLACE PRELIMINARY PLAN. Kevin presented and recommended approval of Evertt's Place Preliminary Plan, which is north of Herman Circle. **MOTION 16-176**. **MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Ortmeier to approve the Evertt's Place Addition Preliminary Plan, Phase 2 & 3 for Herman Otten.

2017 BUDGET. Dawn reviewed a few changes that were made to the 2017 Budget. We are still waiting on estimated costs for 271st St. Reconstruction Project. Second reading will be held at the October 3 meeting.

EXECUTIVE SESSION. MOTION 16-177. MOTION by Fowlds, seconded by Weis to go into executive session at 8:13 pm, pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2 (4) Contracts. All members voted AYE. Council came out of executive session at 8:25 p.m.

MOTION 16-178. MOTION by Ortmeier, seconded by Weis to adjourn at 8:26 pm. All members voted AYE.
