WHEREAS there has been a petition received seeking to include certain real property within the corporate boundaries of the City of Tea; and WHEREAS, the petition has been signed by not less than three-fourths of the registered voters and by the owners of not less than three-fourths of the value of the territory sought to be annexed to the City of Tea; and WHEREAS, the property is contiguous to the City of Tea on its west and north boundaries; and WHEREAS, said petition complies with all requirements of SDCL 9-4-1; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEA, SOUTH DAKOTA that the following described property be and the same hereby are included within the corporate limits of the City of Tea and classified as a Rural Service District as provided for in City of Tea Ordinance 218: and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the boundary of the City is hereby extended to include such territory as allowed by SDCL 9-4-1. SE ¼, Section 23, T100N, R51W * except Bartels Tracts* (aka Parcel 100.50.63.4030 - W ½ SE ¼ 23-100-51; Parcel 100.50.63.4000 - E ½, SE ¼ *ex S 215' of E 304.5' & Bartels Tracts* 23-100-51; and Parcel 100.50.63-4040, S 215' of E 304.5' SE ¼ 23-100-51).
