TEA AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT (TASD) BUILDING PERMIT FEES. There was discussion on what to charge the Tea Area School District for the new Venture Elementary School. In 2015 the City only charged for plan review, water meter, administration fee and site plan review fee. Total fees for the new building would add up to \$42,346.38. **MOTION 18-50. MOTION** by Boots, seconded by Weis to a charge the TASD the following fees: site plan review \$150.00, water and sewer hookup fee \$4,000.00, building plan review \$6,385.00, administration fee \$200.00, rezoning fee \$350.00, annexation fee \$5,632.00, platting fee \$90.00 and building permit fee \$10,000. Total \$26,807.00. All members voted AYE.
