# **ORDINANCE 304**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, SECTION 6.04 MINORS (a) CURFEW HOURS AND EXCEPTIONS AND (c) RESPONSIBILITY OF PARENTS OR GUARDIANS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Tea, Lincoln County that Section 6.04, (a) and (c) be amended as Follows.

### (a) Curfew Hours and Exceptions.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of sixteen (16) years to be on the streets, alleys, or public grounds of the City between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on the following day, and for any person under the age of eighteen (18) to be on the streets, alleys, or public grounds of the City between the hours of 11:00 p.m12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., unless accompanied by parents, legal guardian or some adult person over eighteen (18) years of age having the care and control of said person, or unless such person shall be upon some necessary errand by written permission of a parent, and except approved school functions and activities, and said person so permitted to be outdoors shall have with him or her such written permission and shall upon request of any police officer of the City exhibit the same to said police officer.

### (f) Responsibility of Parents or Guardians.

It shall be unlawful for the parents, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to knowingly permit such a minor to be or remain in or upon the public streets, alleys, parks, playgrounds, public grounds, public places, public buildings, public places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised public places within the City between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 4:006:00 a.m. of the following day, except if the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or when the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed or authorized by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.

## (f) Responsibility of Parents or Guardians.

It shall be unlawful for the parents, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to knowingly permit such a minor to be or remain in or upon the public streets, alleys, parks, playgrounds, public grounds, public places, public buildings, public places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised public places within the City between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. of the following day, except if the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor or when the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed or authorized by his or her parent, guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor.
