**ORDINANCE 287.** The Council held the second reading of Ordinance 287.An Ordinance Creating Zoning Regulations for Cannabis Establishment. There was extensive discussion on what type of establishments would be allowed. As written, the ordinance only allows for dispensaries. Manufacturing, cultivating and testing facilities will not be allowed. **MOTION 21-158. MOTION** by Erck, seconded by Woessner to approve and adopt Ordinance 287. An Ordinance Creating Zoning Regulations for Cannabis Establishment with no amendments. Members Voelker, Erck and Woessner voted AYE. Member Weis and Munson voted NO. Motion carried. The ordinance will be published separately.

**CANNABIS LICENSING ORDINANCE.** There was discussion on the cannabis dispensary licensing procedures. No decisions were made.

**DEVELOPMENT PLAN**. Kevin presented a revised development plan for Nielson Development. The developer ran into wetland issues with the initial development plan. The revised plan will still have senior living options. The Council had concerns with no parking and no sidewalks on the private drive; and the length of E. Dutch Circle. Kevin will go back to the developer with the Council's comments.
