City of Tea Regular Meeting July 6, 2020

A regular meeting of the Tea City Council was held at Tea City Hall on July 6, 2020 at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Lawler called the meeting to order at 7:00 with the following members present: Casey Voelker, Joe Weis, Sidney Munson, Chuck Ortmeier, Jim Erck and Todd Boots. Also present: City Administrator Dan Zulkosky, Planning & Zoning Administrator Kevin Nissen and Finance Officer Dawn Murphy.

CONSENT AGENDA. MOTION 20-88. MOTION by Weis, seconded by Voelker to approve the following July 6, 2020 consent agenda items:

- b) Approval of the June 15, 2020 Meeting Minutes

CONSOLIDATED WATER FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM PROJECT PUBLIC HEARING.

Sara Lum from Southeastern Council of Government briefly reviewed the project and funding. The project is for a 750,000 gallon elevated water storage tank. Estimated cost is \$3.2 million. The city is asking for a 30-year, 2.125% interest loan from Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Annual payments would be approximately \$144,528.64. There were no comments from the public.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION, AND DESIGNATING AN AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE TO CERTIFY AND SIGN PAYMENT REQUESTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Tea (the "City") has determined it is necessary to proceed with improvements to its Drinking Water System, including but not limited to the City of Tea Water Tower Project (the "Project"); and WHEREAS, the City has determined that financial assistance will be necessary to undertake the Project and an application for financial assistance to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources (the "Board") will be prepared; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate an authorized representative to execute and submit the Application on behalf of the City and to certify and sign payment requests in the event financial assistance is awarded for the Project, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City as follows:

- 1. The City hereby approves the submission of an Application for financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$3,200,000 to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources for the Project.
- 2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the Application and submit it to the South Dakota Board of Water and Natural Resources, and to execute and deliver such other documents and perform all acts necessary to effectuate the Application for financial assistance.
- 3. The City Administrator is hereby designated as the authorized representative of the City to do all things on its behalf to certify and sign payment requests in the event financial assistance is awarded for the Project.

CUP #20-05 PUBLIC HEARING. Mayor Lawler opened the public hearing for a Conditional Use Permit for an on-premise sign. Casey's General Stores would like to put up a 870 sq. ft. sign, 100 feet in the air. The sign would be in the Bakker Landing Addition by the interstate. They have received approval from the FAA. Zoning regulations for signs in a General Business District is a maximum of 30' tall and 200 sq. ft. There were no public comments. MOTION 20-90. MOTION by Boots, seconded by Weis to approve On-Premise Sign Conditional Use Permit for Casey's General Stores, Lot 4, Block 2, Bakker Landing 1st Addition. All members voted AYE.

ARLYN OLSEN, Grandstay Hotel Owner, expressed his concerns over recent activities at Squealers Smoke Shop. The City had given them permission to host an outdoor concert on June 20. The hotel had many complaints regarding the parking and noise. Mr. Olsen asked the City to consider adopting a noise ordinance. Mayor Lawler has a meeting set up with the owners of Squealers.

An Ordinance of the City of Tea, SD, Rezoning Bakker Landing 1st Addition, Legally Known as Tract 1, Tract 1A, Tract 4 and Lot 2, Block 6 Bakker Landing 1st Addition (aka Phase 2, Bakker Landing Addition) in the City of Tea from Ag – Agriculture To PD – Planned Development District and Amending the Official Zoning Map of the City of Tea.
