FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 333. The Council held the first reading of Ordinance 333, An Ordinance of the City of Tea, SD, Rezoning Property Located at 1601 East First Street From the R-1 Single Family Residential District to the I-1 Light Industrial District No. 25-02 and Amending the Official Zoning Map of the City of Tea. **MOTION 25-165. EQUIPMENT PURCHASE. Utility Superintendent Konrad received quotes for 2026 budgeted equipment. **MOTION 25-167. MOTION** by Woessner, seconded by Erck to approve the following equipment purchases: 2026 Chevrolet Silverado with options listed, Beck Motors, \$48,616.00; and Toro #72076, Henke Tractor Repair, \$30,575. 2026 HDR ON CALL AGREEMENT. MOTION 25.168. MOTION by Erck, seconded by Woessner to approve the 2026 On-Call Agreement between the City of Tea and HDR Engineering. All members voted AYE.

POLICE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE. One vehicle is budgeted for the Police Department in 2026. Discussion was held regarding whether to purchase one or two vehicles due to changes in the Ford Interceptor body style, as the new body style would require new equipment rather than allowing existing equipment to be transferred. It was the consensus of the council to order one vehicle at this time and revisit a second vehicle mid year.

SIOUX FALLS HUMANE SOCIETY CONTRACT. The renewal of the Sioux Falls Humane Society contract has been received. The monthly fee is increasing from \$800.00 to \$1,000.00, and the after-hours fee is increasing from \$90.00 per hour to \$120.00 per hour. CA Weiland requested a breakdown from the agency detailing the number and types of calls received. No decision was made pending receipt and review of this information.
